When Christ Lutheran Church member Dennis Rader confessed to being BTK on June 27th, the world took note. We sat stunned in our recliners, the remote long forgotten, with queasy stomachs as this confessed criminal recounted the chilling details of how he tortured, strangled, stabbed and shot his 10 victims from 1974 to 1991. Scene-by-scene, blow-by-blow, he dispassionately described his deadly deeds.

“He just referred to these people like rag dolls, like they didn’t exist,” said former Wichita Police Chief Richard LaMunyon, commenting on Rader’s confession in the *Wichita Eagle*. [July 3, 2005]

But when Reformation Lutheran Church member George R. Tiller brags about his late-term child-killing business, few bother to even raise an eyebrow.

“On the first day of the process, an injection of a medication is made into the baby to assure that it will be stillborn,” says Tiller’s web site, dispassionately describing in euphemistic terms how he stabs the viable child through the heart with a poison that murders the baby – a “procedure” he commits again and again, baby after baby. By Tiller’s own admission, he as brutally taken lives thousands and thousands of times.

Inhuman Minds

BTK wasn’t thinking of humans, of women, of children when he murdered. He was simply enjoying his “projects” and making “hits.” What a snapshot of a bizarre, sinful mind!

Likewise, when Tiller kills his victims, they are nothing more that a “problem” to

him. One of Tiller's favorite sayings is, "The woman is the patient, the fetus is the problem."

Every Picture Tells a Story

Of Dennis Rader, police Lieutenant Ken Landwehr said, "He's a sadist... He needs to cause pain." [*Wichita Eagle*, 7/10/05] This would explain why he hung 11-year-old Josephine Otero from a basement sewer pipe and how later in his "career" he derived sick sexual pleasure at his church from the body of Marine Hedge. "I put her on a blanket... took [her] over to Christ Lutheran Church...and took some pictures of her." [State v. Rader, Guilty Pleas, 6/27/05]

"He's proud of what he did," [Police Lt. Ken] Landwehr said. "He can think he's a Christian all he wants...He is nothing but a perverted serial killer." [*L.A. Times*, 7/9/05]

Just as Rader liked to brag, Tiller is proud of his dirty deeds. He proclaims that he has "more experience in late abortion services...than anyone else currently practicing in the Western Hemisphere, Europe, and Australia." [www.drtiller.com]

Like Rader, pictures are a bizarre fetish to Tiller. He photographs the broken, lifeless bodies of the babies he aborts and reportedly keeps some of these photos in an album in his desk. Tiller also injects a religious element into his killing rituals. Often, after the abortion, Tiller will hold a religious service, baptize the dead, mutilated baby, wrap him or her in a blanket and take "family photographs of the baby...cleaned up." Sound familiar? Tiller calls himself a Christian, but is he a shining example for the body of Christ? What happens when salt loses its flavor?

Dr. Jeckle/Mr. Hyde

Rader had worked as a Park City compliance officer, handling suburban code violations and stray dogs. Rader's years of service in the military and "nice guy" impression on co-workers and church friends put up a good front, but others around him noticed something odd. He seemed a stickler for enforcing every infraction and was seen measuring the height of his neighbor's grass to make sure it was within code. Some neighbors avoided him.

Tiller's pastor at Reformation Lutheran Church, Rev. Thomas Halstrom, has described Tiller as a "nice guy, once you get to know him." But others have seen a different side. Former Administrative Director Tracy Jones describes Tiller as "whimsical, arrogant, and tyrannical." This has been proven through the years, with numerous clinic employees leaving because they could not bear his actions or attitude. The acceptance of these two serial killers into the "Church" is an offense to God.

Before his arrest in February, no one imagined Rader was capable of such deviant and malicious behavior. He wasn't an obvious suspect — a 59-year-old married father of two who served as congregation President at Christ Lutheran Church, a member of the

Evangelical Lutheran Congregation of America (ELCA). BTK hid in plain sight. His arrest and subsequent confession to the BTK murders stunned his congregation.

But Tiller's home church, Reformation Lutheran Church, also a member of ELCA, took him into their congregation with their eyes wide open. They were aware that Tiller was an abortionist and were also aware that Holy Cross Lutheran Church had excommunicated Tiller for his unrepentant partaking in the shedding of innocent blood and had in fact kicked him out of the church. Reformation Lutheran Church continues to embrace "Tiller the Killer," even to the point of committing blasphemy by allowing him and his abortion mill co-owner and wife, Jeanne, to partake of Holy Communion! (See picture on opposite page.) In so doing, they openly and knowingly profane the Lord's name and bring shame upon the entire Christian Community of Wichita.

Reformation Lutheran Church certainly bears culpability for enabling Tiller, in allowing him to act outside the conformity to God's Word. But the rest of the Church Community in Wichita must also bear some responsibility. Most pastors and laypersons alike stand idly by and say nothing while hundreds of innocent children are slaughtered each year on the corner of Kellogg and Bleckley. **Silence is Consent!**

Judgment begins with the family of God.

"If you suffer, *it should not be as a murderer* or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler...For it is time for judgment to begin with the family of God." (1 Peter 4:15,17)

Scriptures clearly teach, "Rebuke your neighbor frankly, lest you share in his guilt." (Leviticus 19:17) Just as Reformation Lutheran Church disobeys God when it refuses to rebuke Tiller for the shedding of innocent blood, so also the Church Community shares the responsibility of bloodguilt when it silently tolerates evil, neglecting to call out the sin of the "Butcher of Bleckley."

The Bible gives the Church the authority — and the duty — to discipline and ultimately excommunicate members for unrepentant sinful conduct. 1Corinthians 5:12-13 states, "What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church? Are you not to judge those inside? God will judge those outside. **'Expel the wicked man from among you.'**" Reformation Lutheran has abdicated their responsibility to God in this matter, so it falls next to the Christian Community at large.

It is the duty of the Wichita contingent of the Church of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to call for the excommunication of late-term abortionist George Tiller.

"In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are gathered together, along with

my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. Your glorying is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump? Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened." 1 Corinthians 5:4-7

False Gospel!

The false gospel in the Church allows Dennis Rader to remain a member at Christ Lutheran Church. He has been expelled, not by the church, to their shame, but by the State. Yet while BTK is behind bars, "Tiller the Killer" is still on the loose, hiding in plain sight in the third pew of Reformation Lutheran Church! After 36 years of holding Wichita hostage, Tiller's deadly, despicable deeds can no longer be ignored. "Have nothing to do with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them." (Ephesians 5:11) Don't let your silence implicate you in the murders of innocent children. The Church in Wichita must demand the excommunication of George Tiller, or share in the bloodguilt. Let your voice be heard!

Rader is scheduled for sentencing this month when Justice will be meted out by the State. Let the Church "judge with righteous judgement" (John 7:24) this month by contacting the ELCA leadership and demanding they excommunicate Abortionist George R. Tiller.
