It has come to our attention that there exists a serious problem with the Delta Clinic of Baton Rouge that may involve improper and perhaps illegal activity at the Department of Health and Hospitals.


We have obtained an affidavit from a former patient at the Delta Clinic that alleges horrific treatment for a botched abortion that resulted in a hysterectomy being performed to alleviate the patient's suffering from abortion complications.

In addition, we have obtained documents that indicate that the Delta Clinic of Baton Rouge uses pre-printed forms that are marked ahead of time to indicate that no complications to the abortions ever occur. Those documents are attached.

The patient who submitted the attached affidavit did not have her complication reported to the Department of Health and Hospitals as required by law. There is reason to believe that the DHH has known about the pre-printed forms falsely report abortion information, but have accepted them without consequence, aiding in the illegal cover-up of abortion complications and other abuses in the State of Louisiana.

I am asking you to take a few moments of your time to look over the attached documents and take whatever action is necessary to insure that women are protected from such horrific treatment as the woman involved in the botched abortion. In addition, we ask that you ensure that abortion clinics are held accountable for criminal falsification of records and that possible DHH complicity in an abortion complication cover-up be fully investigated.
