360° SPEAKER SERIES
Each year the Foundation hosts nationally renowned speakers who discuss a range of educational and leadership topics.

SENIOR PROJECTS
The Foundation and Friends are part sponsor and part volunteer for this event. The Senior Projects provide a chance for high school seniors to showcase their research and creative skills. The Foundation supports this project by recruiting community members to review student project proposals, finding mentors for individual student support, and providing judges to review the final project presentation.

This program is being designed to teach high school students various styles of leadership, how to run a meeting, get organized, and work with a team to complete projects.
