Dear Ms. Juris:

I noticed that you issued yet another RFAI letter to Trust Women PAC on December 4, 2013, concerning the July Quarterly Report.

As you may be aware, I have filed a complaint with the Commission regarding Trust Woman PAC, alleging serious violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A non-notarized copy of my complaint, and addendum, is included for your reference.

My complaint shows that amended reports will not be a sufficient method of dealing with Trust Women PAC. The committee has failed to file an acceptable report with your office since October 2011. Evidence indicates that this failure is not due to incompetence alone, but rather to corruption, financial impropriety, and possible criminal malfeasance on the part of management.

In your RFAI, you noted that an audit or enforcement action may be forthcoming, should Trust Women PAC fail to respond adequately.

In light of the committee's blatant disregard for previous Commission requests, I request that the Commission conduct a full and immediate audit of the committee, above and beyond any formal investigation on the part of Complaints Examination and Legal Administration arising from my complaint.

I further request that any infractions discovered in such an audit result in the maximum enforcement action, and that all perpetrators of criminal activity be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
